







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	<p>subtract 10s, add 2-digit numbers, solve missing number problems using addition and subtraction.</p> <p>Fridays Year 1 Length and Height – comparing length and heights, measuring lengths using objects and centimetres. Mass and Volume – we will finish the half term with an introduction to mass and volume. This will include comparing what is heavier and lighter and measuring mass.</p> <p>Year 2 Shape - sorting 2D shapes, identifying properties of 3D shapes, making patterns with 2D and 3D shapes.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p>	<p>Science – Our project this half term is called Habitats. We will learn what a habitat is and what a habitat needs to provide. In turn, we will explore local habitats to identify and name living things, and we will begin to understand how they depend on one another for food and shelter.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">RE</p> 	<p>In Religious Education, both Year 1 and 2 will be considering the question, 'Why is learning to do good deeds so important for Jewish people?' We will consider what a good deed is and the impact of these good deeds on others. Through exploring the Jewish story of Ruth, we will identify the varying good deeds and make links to other religions – in particular, Christianity.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">History</p> 	<p>This half term, our History project is all about Celebrations and Commemorations. We will think about Remembrance Day and why we wear poppies in November.</p> <p>Monet Class will also reflect on their prior learning about Bonfire Night and learn the story of the plot and what went wrong. We will also investigate the life of Guy Fawkes and the role he played within society.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Art and Design</p> 	<p>Our focus for design this half term is mechanisms. The children will explore and create different mechanisms including sliders and levers and learn about how each moves. Then with their new knowledge, the children will create a greeting card with a moving part using their mechanism of choice.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Music</p> 	<p>The children will continue to develop their understanding of notation and pitch using the ocarina and songs using the solfege scale. We will review beat and rhythm, spend time learning about the composer Vivaldi and find beats and rhythms in his compositions.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">PSHE</p> 	<p>Emotions –This half term children will develop their understanding of their own emotions and those of others. They will identify a range of emotions, develop language to describe them, and consider what prompts different feelings in themselves and others. They will explore how those emotions affect how we think, feel and behave, including impulsive and considered behaviours. In order to enable them to develop positive self-esteem, they will identify what is special about themselves, including their skills as well as their character.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">PE</p>	<p>PE – Indoor PE will continue with our Dance unit 'Moving Words'. The children will create, perform and share short dances based on action words.</p>




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	<p>Games will focus on fundamental movement skills; with the children engaging in team games and simple competitive physical activities to develop control and co-ordination in large and small movements. Focus will transfer to sending and receiving from throwing and catching to kicking and trapping and striking with a bat.</p>
<p>Please remember</p>	<p>All - Indoor PE kit on a Monday and outdoor PE kit for a Wednesday. All - Water bottles will be sent home on a Friday and need to be returned to school on a Monday. All – the children will have a Mathletics task to complete each week. Their log in details can be found in their reading diaries. It is really important that all children access this home learning as it will consolidate their learning in school. All – a spare change of clothes and outdoor shoes (such as wellies) should be kept in school in case of wet weather. Year 1 – Please practise writing our simple spelling list containing new graphemes and tricky words. The list will come home on a Thursday and children will have a quiz the following Thursday. Year 1 – Please access your child's Big Cat Collins e-book on line. Pupils will have practised this book 3 times on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. Afterwards, it will be released and ready for your child to read at home. Please read this book over several days. We welcome comments to be written in your child's reading diary to let us know how they are reading independently. Year 1 - Please bring your sharing books to school in a book bag (as these fit into the children's drawers – no rucksacks please). Sharing books will be changed at the beginning of each morning. Year 1 – the children will access TT Rockstars in the Spring when they have covered a unit on multiplication.</p>
