

Literacy/English: Texts: The Night Pirates, Mrs Pirate and Information books about Pirates

EYFS: Learning Phase 5 phonics for reading which will also review the sounds learned so far.

Writing labels, captions, speech bubbles and simple sentences.

Practising the correct formation of letters in the cursive style.

Year 1:

Phase 5 Phonics which looks at the alternative ways of spelling the same sound.

Writing a story based on the ideas from, 'The Night Pirates'.

Writing a report text about Pirates which will include researching facts about famous pirates.

Beginning to practise joining letters.
