The secret-agent embarks on a mission to save the world from the evil Dr Hammer and his evil, fishy minions. We will write our own pieces of engaging dialogue, using all our punctuation/grammatical skills, between Spy Fox and Dr Hammer. Additionally, we will plan, draft and publish our own adventure stories for Spy Fox encountering a different 'villain' and 'mission' using the appropriate structural/language toolkit for adventure stories.

Year 5 – Mrs McCabe's Group Place Value *Understand the place value of numbers up to one million. *Compare and order any number. *Round numbers to varying degrees of accuracy. *Calculate with negative numbers. Science	 Properties and Changes of Materials – continued from last half-term We will learn about mixtures and how they can be separated using sieving, filtration and evaporation. We will also study reversible and irreversible changes, and use common indicators to identify irreversible changes.
Science	 Human Reproduction and Ageing Picasso will learn about animal life cycles, including the human life cycle. We will explore human growth and development to old age, including the changes experienced during puberty and human reproduction. (Linked to PSHE)

RE	 Our Big Question this half term is Creation or Science: conflicting or complimentary? We will identify what type of text some Christians believe Genesis 1 is; suggest what Genesis 1 might mean and compare our ideas with ways Christians interpret it, showing awareness of different interpretations. Picasso will aim to make clear connections between Genesis 1 and the Christian belief about God as Creator; showing an understanding of why many Christians find science and faith go together.
History Were ancient Greece	 Ground breaking Greeks – continued from last half term This project will teach Picasso about developments and changes over six periods of ancient Greek history. Picasso will focus on the city state of Athens in the Classical age and explore the lasting legacy of ancient Greece.
Computing - Information Technology	Year 5 - Tinkercad
	The children will learn how to create simple and complex 3D models, add detail and manipulate 3D models using a variety of tools. Year 6 - Film making and editing The children will learn how green screens are used in movies. In groups, they will then plan and film their own movie sequence, researching content and backgrounds to create a film. As they progress through this unit, they will be exposed to topic-based language and develop the skills of capturing, editing, and manipulating video.
PE	 Ficasso will develop their skills of fielding balls travelling at different heights and speeds, as well as be able to catch balls thrown at different heights, speeds and distances. They will learn to accurately bowl underarm and start to demonstrate technique for overarm bowling.
ART/DT	Set Design
	 This project allows Picasso to create a model set for theatre or animation. They will explore the work of designers/makers and then create their own model "sets" around the theme of Aladdin. Our visit to Holland Park Opera will enable us to have the opportunity to hear directly from the set designer about the process of designing a set through to seeing it ready for a performance of The Merry Widow.

Dramatically, we will be able to develop and express our vocabulary, language and communication skills.
