**Delegated responsibilities: - Data, Evaluation and Monitoring Committee**  
**2024/2025**

The Data, Evaluation and Monitoring Committee has delegated powers and duties as follows: -

- The committee shall ensure that safeguarding is discussed at every meeting.
- To undertake monitoring and evaluation of teaching and learning within the school focussing on children's progress and attainment.
- Provide information, with assistance from the staff, to the Full Governing Body about the Curriculum, including how it is planned, taught, evaluated and resourced.
- Monitor the attainment of all children including those with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities, Pupil Premium Funded; Service children and C.I.C.
- To advise the Governing Body on :
  - Their Statutory obligations regarding the National Curriculum
  - Guidance from the Diocese.
  - Guidance from the LA
- To understand and be aware of the statutory obligations on testing and the publishing of school performance data.
- To be involved with the ongoing cycle of self-evaluation in order to accurately identify key priorities for school development.
- To monitor the school's progress in relation to the School Development Plan.
