Delegated Responsibilities – Data, Evaluation and Monitoring Committee (DEM)

The Data, Evaluation and Monitoring Committee has delegated powers and duties as follows: -

- The committee shall ensure that safeguarding is discussed at every meeting.
- To undertake monitoring and evaluation of teaching and learning within the school focussing on children's targets, progress and attainment.
- Provide information, with assistance from the staff, to the Full Governing Body about the curriculum, including how it is planned, taught, evaluated and resourced.
- Monitor the attainment of all children including those with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities, Pupil Premium Funded; Service children and C.I.C/ LAC/ PLAC.
- To advise the Governing Body on :
 - Their Statutory obligations regarding the national curriculum
 - Guidance from the Diocese.
 - Guidance from the LA
- To understand and be aware of the statutory obligations on testing and the publishing of school performance data.
- To be involved with the ongoing cycle of self-evaluation in order to accurately identify key priorities for school improvement.
- To monitor the schools progress in relation to the School Development Plan
