Abbots Ripton School Junior ParkRun Takeover

Abbots Ripton School will be 'taking over' Jubilee Junior ParkRun on Sunday 21st May. It is a fun, free, welcoming, and inclusive event, a 2km walk or run for children aged 4-14. It would be great to have as many children as possible running or walking and as many family and friends as possible cheering the children on or, better still, volunteering to marshal.

All you need to do is pre-register your child and turn up to the event. When: Please arrive by 8.45am for a group photo and an introduction if your child is running or 8.30 if you are volunteering to marshal at the event. There is a fun warm-up at 9am and the event gets underway shortly after that.

Where: Jubilee Park, Kings Ripton Road, Huntingdon. There is a large car park, toilets and a café serving hot and cold drinks and bacon rolls. More information can be found here: https://www.parkrun.org.uk/jubilee-juniors/

You will be assigned a barcode to print out - or keep on your phone - to bring along. When your child crosses the finish line, they will be given a token. They present the token and

the barcode to timing marshals to have their time and finish position recorded for posterity. You will receive an email an hour or two after the event confirming it all.
