

Collective Worship this half term – Perseverance



Over the next few weeks we will be reflecting on the value of perseverance. We will think about how hard we try in different situations, what helps us to keep trying as well as the idea of ambition. From the bible, we will reflect on the letter written to Timothy by Paul, where he uses a series of images to help his readers – that of a soldier, of an athlete and of a farmer (2 Timothy 2:3-7). Each one needs dedication if they are to win the battle, complete the race, or produce a good

harvest. Most good things in life only come with time, patience, dedicated effort and perseverance. Christians believe that this is also true in the realm of faith. For example, Jesus advises his followers not to give up in prayer (Luke 18:1-8).

- o Good quality, clean soft toys TEDDY TOMBOLA


All donations can be sent into school from Friday 30th June.
