# **Supporting learning**

Mathletics

As a school, we invest a portion of our budget in order to give children access to 2 really good online learning tools **Mathletics** and **TTRockstars**; Mathletics is a brilliant website as it mirrors exactly what we teach in school including the same

images, mathematical language etc. Teachers will set units of learning each week in line with class content and we ask that children spend time completing these. It is a fantastic way to reinforce and consolidate learning. We anticipate this taking Monet class about 10-15 minutes per week, Kandinsky class about 15-20 minutes and Picasso class about 20-30 minutes.

Learning times tables and the inverse division facts are a core strand of primary school mathematics as so much maths relies on knowledge and quick recall of



these facts. Please do support your child (Years 2 to 6) to engage with TTRockstars for at least 10 minutes a week – although the more they do, the quicker they'll get!!!

# EBooks

We are aware that those children in school who should begin reading their e-books this week currently can not access them. Please bear with us as we have been informed that there is a technical issue with our account. We will let parents know as soon as the system is back up and running.

# Uniform

We have noticed that some children are not yet wearing the correct school uniform. Please could we politely ask that parents check our <u>uniform policy</u> to ensure that children are wearing the correct uniform. This includes ensuring appropriate black school shoes and a school jumper and/or cardigan and black or grey skirts/trousers – rather than leggings. Summer dresses are still appropriate too until you think your child might be too cold!

A reminder that long hair should also be tied back and the only allowable jewellery is small stud earrings. Children should also not be wearing visible temporary tattoos or nail varnish.

In relation to PE kit, please could we ask that children wear their black jogging bottoms over shorts and not 'skins' to keep them warm. We need to see their joints (knees) during dance and gymnastic activities.

Please always make sure that your child has a warm coat as we will try to be outside at playtimes as much as possible. It is also advisable to send a change of footwear (wellies or old trainers) in a named plastic bag for when the field is wet.
