English:

Adventure Stories - Wombat Goes Walkabout. Sentence stacking. Use of repetition and onomatopoeia for effect. Developing powerful adjectives and action verbs. Questions with speech punctuation. Write the story from the viewpoint of another animal, explaining how wombat saved them. Non-Chronological Report: Write a report to be displayed on a zoo exhibit, describing an Australian animal. Temporal conjunctions. Paragraphs with sentences that include and explain detail. Introduction explaining content to follow and summary conclusion of topic.

Geography: Name and locate the World's seven continents and five oceans. Understand Geographical differences and similarities through studying human and physical geography between Abbots Ripton and Australia.

Computing: Understand how green screens can be used in photography and film. Creating photos of ourselves in Australia. Year I will edit these using the Pic Collage app and Year 2 will use these in the Book Creator app. Art: Traditional Aboriginal art – exploring line, pattern, form & space in different media.



Science: Monet scientists will explore, investigate and answer questions about everyday materials and their properties. We will work scientifically by performing tests to explore the best possible materials for different situations and review our results. Maths Year 1:

Multiplication Making equal groups. Counting in multiples of 2,5 and 10. Division Sharing, grouping. Place value to 100 Counting to 100. Partitioning numbers. Comparing numbers. Ordering numbers. Finding one more and one less.

Year 2:

Division Revising division by 2/5/10. Statistics: Make tally charts. Draw and interpret pictograms. Block diagrams. Position and direction: Describe movement and turns. Make patterns with shapes.

PSHE: Diversity and Community. What is a stereotype? Who helps people in my locality and what help do these people need? What does 'my community' mean and how does it feel to be part of it?

RE: How do some Muslims show Allah is compassionate and merciful?

<u>PE:</u> Monet will be developing their **games** skills for striking and fielding. **Dance** – The weather.
