## **Football Festivals**



As a cluster of schools we have been busy organising a calendar of Football Festivals for our keen footballers from Year 1 to Year 6. Each half term, a selection of children from the respective year group will spend the day at St Ives Football Club, where they will spend the morning practising skills and learning drills and in the afternoon they will compete against 7 other local schools in a tournament. The event will host 100 children from the 8 schools and this term our Year 5 and 6 children will take part (see diary

dates). A selection of our Year 3 and 4 children will take part in the Spring term and in the Summer term it will be the turn of our Year 1s and 2s.

## **Parking**

We are very aware that parking in the car park has become a real concern for many parents. Some parents have discussed this with us and we come up with a list of possible ways to alleviate the congestion:

- Car share as much as possible – parents could take it in turns to bring a small group of friends.
- If you have a child who is happy for you to 'drop and go' it means that you can enter and leave the car park swiftly, freeing a space for someone else.
- We have contacted the Abbots Elm Pub who are happy for parents to use their car park for drop up and pick up but they have requested that parents are as prompt as possible. I have agreed to review this with them in a couple of weeks to see if it has caused any issues for them – we are extremely grateful to them for this offer!
- St Andrews Church are happy for parents to use the church car park but again request that parents are prompt as they may have something such as a funeral happening in the church.
- As always, please park with care e.g. as close to the edge and as close to other cars as possible to maximise the space.



I would like to take this opportunity to remind parents that children should be well supervised in the car park as lots of vehicles are moving and reversing.
