- Provide this on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> September which s the first day back to school

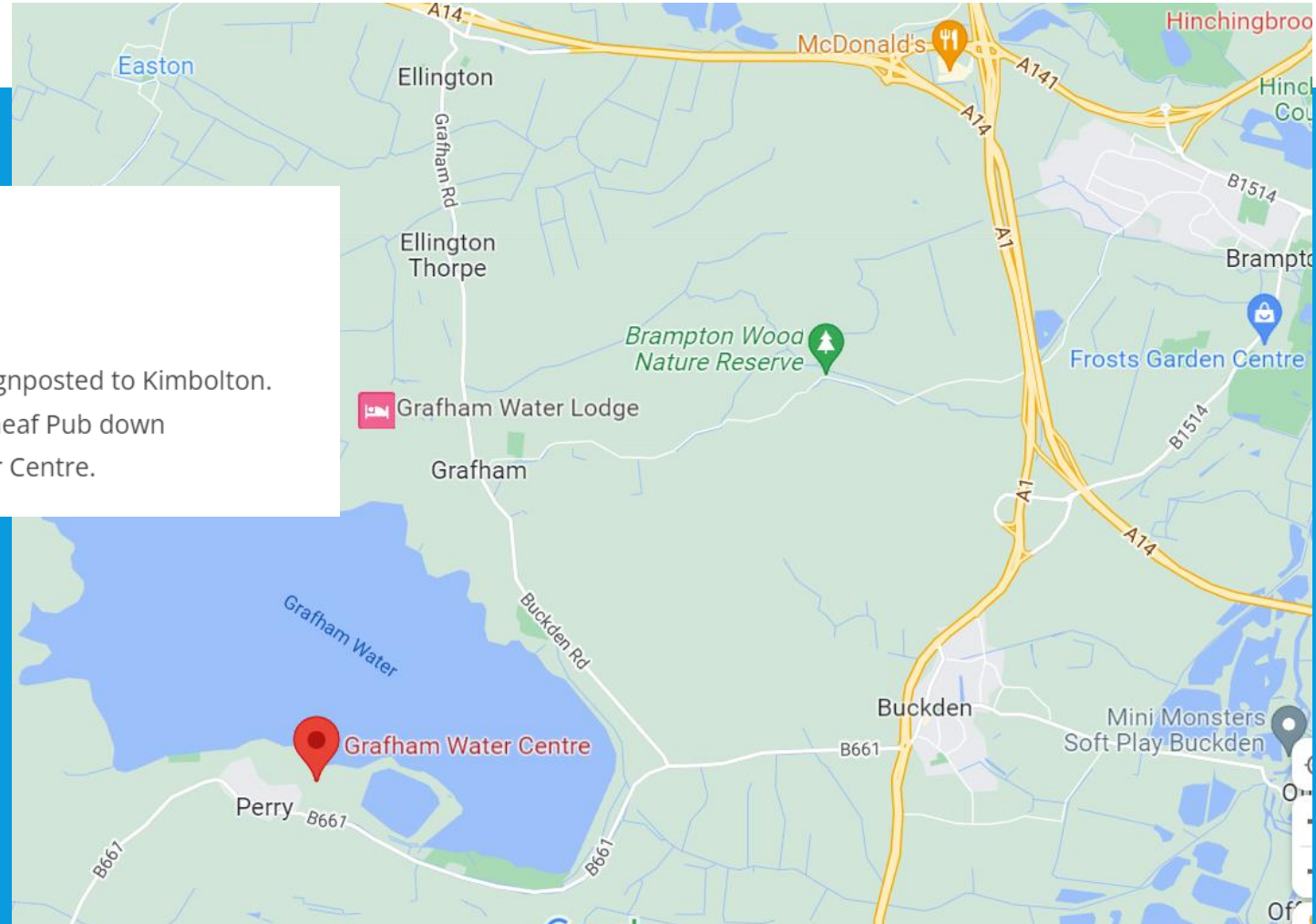


# DROP OFF AND PICK UP
