## Welcome back!

- We are looking forward to welcoming you all back to school, but the school may look a little different than when you left it. There won't be as many staff in school and you won't be able to visit lots of rooms in school.
- These changes have been made to help keep us all safe. We have taken some photographs so that you can get an idea of what it will look like on Monday.



## 2 metre markers

- On the paths into school, on the field from the car park, you will find blue lines that are separated by 2 metres.
- Please use these when entering and leaving the school site to maintain your distance from others.



## 2 metre markers

- These are the blue markers coming into the school from the front gate, to be used by Year 6.
- It also shows the markers at the side of the school leading to the entrance for Year 6.



## Year 6 bubble

- Year 6 children will be taught in the Kandinsky classroom.
- The adults working in this classroom will be Mrs Jackson, Mrs Pollock and Mrs Upshall.
- Some desks have been moved to allow them to be separated by at least 2 metres.
- Each desk will seat one of you.



## Year 6 bubble

- Each of you will have your own workstation and a box to keep your resources in.
- Resources should not be shared between your friends.
- Your desks and chairs will be cleaned through the day.
- Only bring your coats and lunch bags from home and these will be placed in your box.



## Reception and Year 1 bubble

- You will be in your usual Van Gogh classroom.
- The adults working with this bubble are Mrs Wilcock, Mrs Hawthorne and Mrs Murray.
- You will have your own workstation and a yellow tray to keep your resources in.
- Resources should not be shared between your friends.
- Your desks and chairs will be cleaned through the day.
- Your lunch bags will be placed under desks and coats hung on the backs of chairs.




Reception and Year 1 bubble

- In the outside area many of the resources are still in place so you will recognise them.
- Some extra things have been added for example, a second muddy kitchen so that you can still play alongside your friends.



Key worker bubble

- You will be in the Monet classroom.
- The adults working in this bubble are Miss Slater and Mrs Richardson.
- Some desks have been moved to allow them to be separated by at least 2 metres.
- You will each have your own desk and a green tray to keep your resources in.
- Resources should not be shared between your friends.
- Your desks and chairs will be cleaned through the day.



Play equipment

- You will not be able to share play equipment with your friends in the normal way.
- Your teachers will show you where to put the equipment ready to be cleaned so that someone else can use it at another time.
