Harvest Donations

Our Harvest Thanksgiving Service will be on Monday 9th October at 9:30am across in the church. Parents are invited to join us in the church, but if you have a child in Van Gogh Class we would be grateful for your support in walking with the children to the church. Please come to school at 9:20am to walk across with us if you are able.

Donations again this year will be taken to the Salvation Army's Kings Ripton Court in Huntingdon. Kings Ripton Court is a Salvation Army Lifehouse based in Huntingdon that supports young people aged 16-25 years, experiencing homelessness.



Through your generosity in donating food produce, they are able to provide new residents with a food parcel on arrival as part of their 'welcome pack' so that they can focus on settling in during their first few days. Donations also enable the team to provide emergency food provision to any

residents who may be struggling financially and also use the produce as part of their Lifeskills Programme which helps the young people develop skills needed for independent living.

They would particularly appreciate donations of drinking squash, dried pasta, rice, long life milk and tinned food (e.g. tuna). Donations can be brought into school from Tuesday via your child. Sadly they are unable to accept any fresh produce.

We have recently noticed some children bringing in cereal bars and crisps. Also, children in Monet and Van Gogh do not need to bring a snack as this is provided each day at school. This is important in Van Gogh class as snack time is part of the classroom time and it is difficult if children bring their own snack. Many thanks for your support with this.

Secondary 2024-2025 applications must be submitted by the 31st October and all on time applications will receive a school allocation on the National Offer date of the 1st March 2024. Parents who do not submit their application on time will need to complete a late

Microsoft Teams - Year 6



As part of our Computing curriculum last year we trialled a new way for children to collaborate, save and share their computing learning online using Microsoft Teams. We were supported by Cambridgeshire ICT Service in setting up Microsoft Teams accounts for the children and it was a great success. We will be continuing this again this year.

Teams allows the children to save their learning in such a way that they can access it out of school. The children will start to work on a PowerPoint in small groups and they will be able to access this from home to continue with their project, if they wish. However, they are also able to communicate with the other children in the class. As with our Learning Platform STARZ, we are able to monitor this communication. We will remind the children that this method of communication should only be related to their learning and to enable the teams to collaborate on their PowerPoint out of school.

We would be grateful if you could reiterate this message at home if your child does access their Teams account.
